**To apply, you must currently attend one of the Texas A&M University campuses and have a TAMU UIN. Your applications must include:**

- Completed and signed application (Incomplete applications will not be considered.)
- Well-written essay fully addressing the provided prompt
- One letter of recommendation
- Unofficial copy of transcript from HOWDY Portal with overall and major GPA
- Optional: resumé of current activities, accomplishments, involvement, volunteerism, etc...

***\*\*Do not provide old or outdated documents/letters. Transcripts should be the most current. Resumés must be for collegiate activities (not high school). The essay should be based on current perspectives.***

Applications will not be considered without all the required items and info. All must be mailed and postmarked no later than March 27, 2026. Scholarship recipients will be contacted by email or phone call later in the spring.

- 1. APPLICATION FORM COMPLETED AND SIGNED
- 2. TAMU TRANSCRIPT WITH OVERALL & MAJOR GPA (An unofficial transcript from HOWDY Portal will be accepted.)
- 3. ESSAY: *Which A&M tradition captivated you the most and will make the biggest impact on your life going forward?* (500-750 words/1000 maximum; include full name, email, and cell # as your heading.)
- 4. REFERENCE LETTER: One (1) reference letter that vouch for your personal character and work ethic from employers, advisors, teachers, coaches, or mentors. No relatives, please.
- 5. RESUMÉ (optional, but encouraged): current activities, honors, involvement, volunteerism, etc...
