Your application must include:

- This completed and signed application (Applications without a UIN will not be considered.)
- A well-written essay that fully addresses the provided prompt
- Full resumé that includes activities, clubs, organizations, sports, leadership positions, service opportunities, community involvement, and any other participation, honors, or accolades
- Three letters of recommendation vouching for your character and work ethic
- Official transcript with your GPA (on 4.0 scale) and grade records
- Applications will not be considered without all the required items and info.

GCCISD candidates must submit applications according to GCCISD's requirements and deadlines. The district will provide applications to our committee for consideration.

Students applying independently (not through your school) must submit applications by mail **postmarked by March 27, 2026**. Scholarship recipients will be contacted by email or phone call later in the spring.

- ☐ 5. REFERENCE LETTERS: Three (3) reference letters that vouch for your personal character and work ethic from employers, advisors, teachers, coaches, or mentors. No relatives, please.
